“Twenty-Five Years Ago, Peanuts Were A No-Account Crop. Today, The Virginia Variety Is Known The World Over” - workers in field,
“-And In Texas, 205,000 Acres Of Land, Just Like This, Grow Nothing Else But!” - African-American workers behind horse-drawn plows, “Harvest Time!”, “From The Distance They Resemble Hay Stacks”,
“The Way It Was Done In The Old Days”, - CU hands picking peanuts
“The Way It’s Done Now-By Machinery”, “The Machines Separate The Peanut From The Vine”, “But Machines Have Their Limitations. It Takes Fingers To Do This -“ - man tying up bundle, “-And Now The Peanuts Are Ready For Market.” - horse-drawn wagons loaded with sacks of peanuts, “Each Man, Woman And Child In The United States, Consumes Nearly A Bushel A Year” - peanuts falling out of large container,
“Of Course, Boys Are Exceptions To This Rule. Nobody Knows How Much It Takes To Fill Them!” - boy at peanut stand
