- parade with soldiers (uniforms of Confederate Army), autos, Mexican  
men on bicycles, banners, horse-drawn carriages, many jubilant Revolution  
people, crowd throwing confetti MR-4 & MR-5
- 15:54:16 “Venustiano Carranza And Gral. Obregon During The Parade.”  
- continuation of parade, Carranza on horseback with white beard  
taking off his hat, Obregon next to him taking off his hat
- 15:54:53 “Pancho Villa. Soldiers ‘Los Dorados’ Ready To Enter Mexico City.”  
- LS mounted soldiers riding on crowd lined street, still  
photographers, Zapata on horse with large whiter hat
- 15:55:48 “Triumfal [sic] Entrance Of Pancho Villa.”  
-continued from above - Villa on white horse with white hat with  
other mounted soldiers (no uniforms), Villa surrounded by crowd,  
large crowd watching parade of soldiers, some people standing  
on trolley car
- 15:57:24 “Pancho Villa Visiting Madero’s Sepulchral Monument.”  
-Villa and Carranza walking to tomb, CS Pancho Villa at tomb,  
Carranza (with beard and top hat), Villa and Carranza at tomb,  
Carranza reading and Villa listening
- 15:58:59 “On The 15<sup>th</sup>, Of July 1928, Gral. Obregon Makes His Entrance At  
Mexico City.”  
- crowd waiting at train station, train arriving at station, Obregon  
leaving in auto
- 16:00:20 “Tuesday The 17th, Gral. (abbrev. for General) Obregon Was [also on 1C01  
Assassinated At The ‘La Bombilla’ Restaurant.” 05:54:53-05:58:44]  
- crowd in street, hearse passing by escorted by soldiers on horses,  
bi-planes flying over, train arriving, men carrying wreaths
- 16:02:15 “The Remains Were Transferred [sic] To Railroad Station On Their  
Way To Native State Of Sonora.”  
- funeral train pulling out with railroad workers (they had supported  
Obregon) participating in funeral train to Sonora, Aurelio Mannique  
(leader of Agrarian Party, Gov. of San Luis Potosi) speaking from train,  
unknown man speaking from train, Aaron Saenze (Foreign Minister,  
close to Obregon and Calles), train leaving station
